Seek shade structures during peak sun hours.



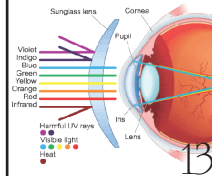

Always choose **sunglasses** that are labeled as blocking **99-100% UV rays.**



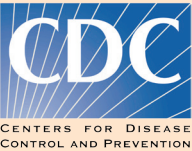

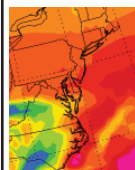
